Loddiswell Parish Council hereby advise the electorate of a 30-working day period during which your public rights may be exercised. The Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 as summarised in the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2015 (Statutory Instrument No. 234), and the Code of Audit Practice require that:

Each year the Council's Annual Return is audited by an auditor appointed by Public Sector Audit Appointments Limited. Any person interested has the right to inspect and make copies of the accounts to be audited. There is a charge made for copies. Any such inspection will need to work within any health guidelines in existence at the time.

For the year ended 31st March 2025, these documents will be available on reasonable notice at an agreed location (on a working day within the hours of 10 am to 12 pm) on application to:

Fiona Stace (Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer), Loddiswell Parish Council via contact details above. Working days are defined as Monday – Friday. They do not include Saturdays, Sundays and Bank holidays.

The inspection period commences on 2nd June 2025 and ends on 11th July 2025

Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the Council contact above.
